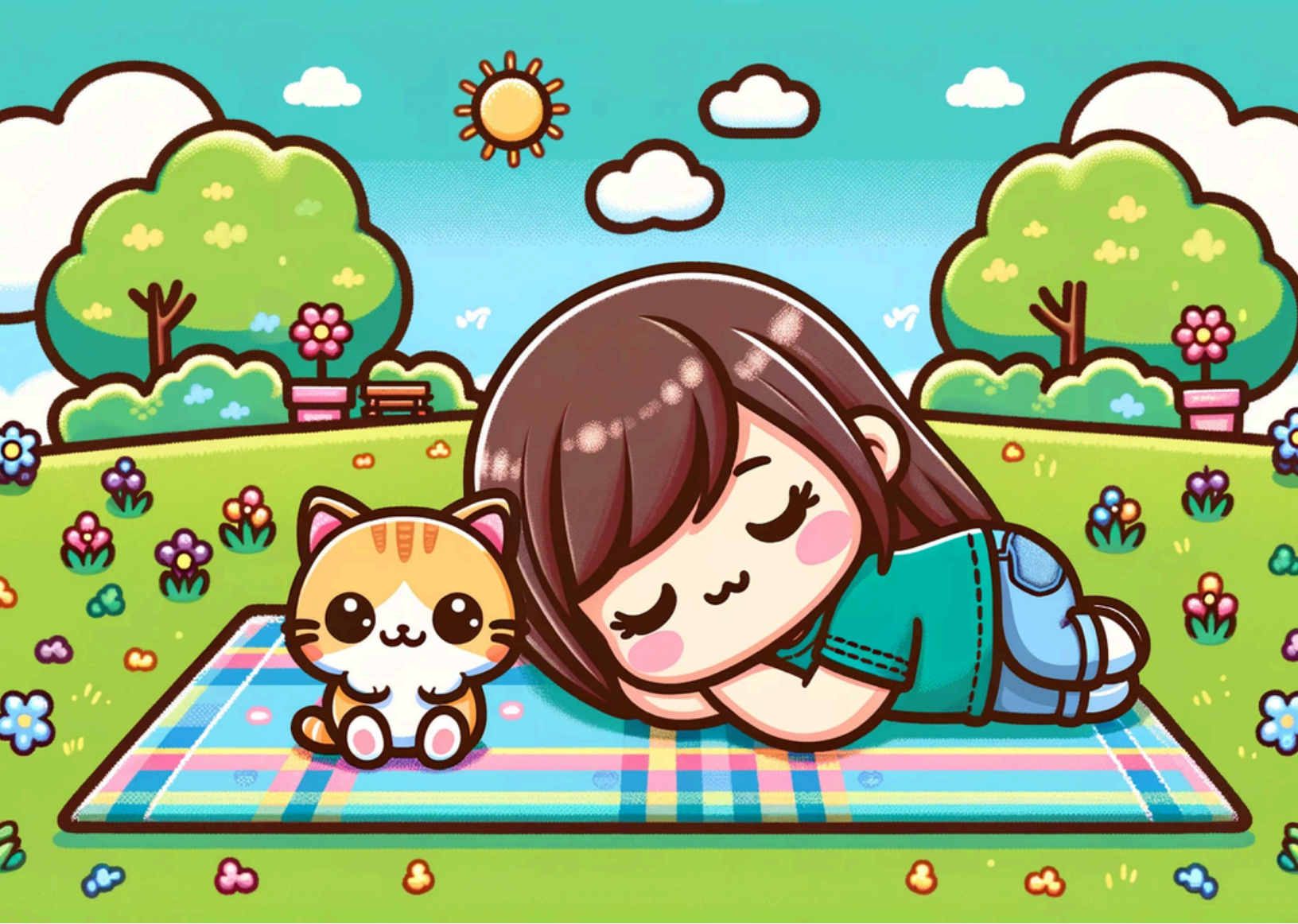


Pam and The Cat
