that noise in the air!

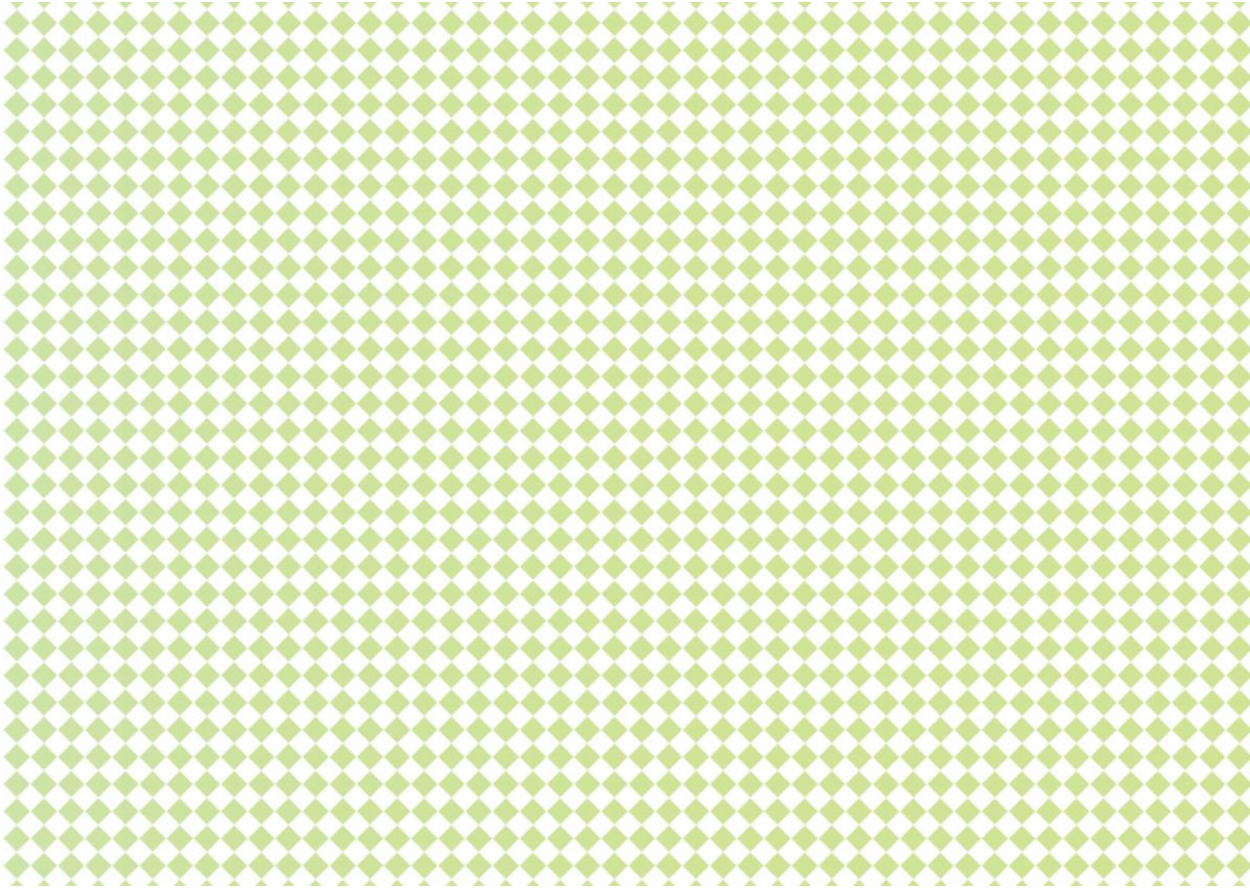


Try climb one more branch,

Sloth in their tree.







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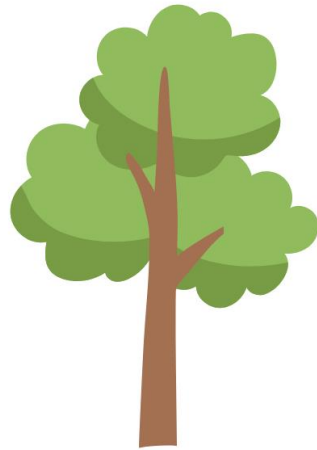

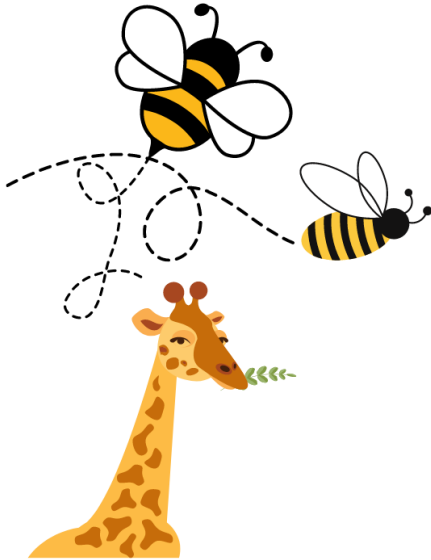
